



2017-18 FALL/WINTER PROGRAM - STARSKATE INFORMATION FORM

START WEDNESDAY SEPTEMBER 6, 2017 TO MARCH 28, 2018

General Information

- Pre-season ice starts Wednesday, September 6th, 2017 at Thames Campus Arena.
- See attached Pre-Season Calendar for times and session information.
- Regular season ice starts Monday, September 18th, at Thames Campus Arena.
- All prices have been adjusted for “No Skate Days”, “StarSkate Test Days” and revised schedule dates.
- Skaters are only entitled to skate on sessions they are registered for.
- Skaters must pay “guest fees” on all other sessions. (please see pricing below)
- Level **A Skater** must have passed complete Senior Bronze Freeskate OR Junior Silver Skills OR complete Junior Silver Dances OR new STAR equivalency (in draft mode by Skate Canada for STAR 6^).
- Level **B Skater** must have passed complete Preliminary Freeskate (STAR 3) AND Preliminary Skills (STAR 3), OR be registered in Grade 9 as of September 2017.

Payment

- Full Payment via **CASH or CHEQUE is due at time of registration.**
- Payment can be made via four post-dated cheques of equal payments. Required payment dates are the date of registration, October 1st, November 1st and December 1st.
- There is a \$15 NSF Fee for any returned cheques.
- A pro-rated late fee will be charged on all registrations received after Monday, September 18th.

Refunds

- Refunds will only be allowed within 2 weeks of first skated session except for medical reasons.
- A doctor's note will be required for medical reason refunds.
- The Skate Canada fees are non-refundable.

Guest Fees – (must be paid with envelopes provided and deposited in guest fee box)

- \$10.00 – 30min Dance/Skills Session.
- \$15.00 -- 45min Open Skate/FreeSkate
- \$20.00 – 1hr - 1.25hrs Open Skate/FreeSkate
- \$25.00 – 1.5hrs Open Skate or 1.25hrs that includes 15min Coaching (Instructor Led techniques).
- \$30.00 – 1.75hrs Open Skate or 1.75hrs that includes 15min Coaching (Instructor Led techniques).

Group C – Level C Skater

- For skaters who have advanced from CanSkate. Must have passed Stage 6 or on recommendation from Coach or Director.
- Will be organized, paid and facilitated between Skater, Parent/Family and Professional Coach.

Instructor Led

- Offered in the last 15 min. of AB Open on Wednesdays AND BC FreeSkate on Wednesdays.
- Will be coached by an alternating, club hired, scheduled and dedicated Professional Coach.
- No other coaches or un-registered skaters will be coaching/skating during this time.
- Skaters will be instructed on various skating techniques including stroking and edges etc.
- Pricing is included in package sessions. Will not be offered as separate pricing or refunded for non use.

Punch Card

- Will be offered for Saturday sessions only from 8:30-10am.
- Cannot be used for any other skating sessions and will expire after this current skating season.
- Must be punched and initialed by a CFSC Director.
